CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The committee of Moora District & Horsemen's Association (MHA) reserve the right to cancel, alter or combine any event/s they may deem necessary on the day.

If you are not a riding member of MHA or EA, you are required to pay a day membership for insurance purposes to be able to compete.

The grounds are public open space and cannot be sealed from the public access. All entrants must sign the declaration, or they will NOT be allowed to compete.

All persons on horseback are required to wear EA recognised standard approved helmet and boots as a condition of entry (please note new helmet standards apply as of Jan 2017, it is rider responsibility to ensure your helmet complies with this).

Rider's age will be at the day of event (proof of age may be requested).

All ponies can be ridden by any age unless otherwise stated.

MHA organising committee reserves the right to interpret all rules & make a decision where any dispute arises.

Under No circumstances is approaching the judge, judging or coaching from the side of the ring permitted. Failure to abide by these rules will lead to immediate disqualification and forfeit of entry fees.

“NO” Dogs are permitted on the grounds. Dogs will be removed.

All manure, hay and rubbish must be removed from your float parking (i.e. on the ground) area prior to departing

Riding on the grounds is not permitted if you are not entered in an event

The organizing committee of the MHA, judges, officials, DO NOT accept liability for any accident, loss, damage, illness or injury to horses, owners, riders, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever. Entry to the grounds is at your own risk and the 'Waiver of Liability' form must be signed by all entrants prior to participation; this is a condition of our insurance.

Where other events clash with other events, riders must choose which event they ride. No event classes will be delayed due to riders not able to ride due to event class clash.

No Whips or spurs are to be used in handy pony events

Riders competing in Lead Line and 1st Ridden classes must only compete in lead line & 1st Ridden classes

Plaiting and jackets are optional

Horses and ponies should be clean and riders dressed in neat attire

NOTE – A lunch break will be offered for Judge in the Hack rings.

EVENT CLASS DESCRIPTION

1. Lead Line & first Ridden – Smartest on Parade
2. Lead Rein – for riders on a lead rein. (Not eligible for first ridden.)
3. First Ridden – (First horse/pony to be ridden with competitor off the lead rein.)
4. Lead Rein Handy Pony
5. First Ridden Handy Pony
6. Smartest on Parade – 14hh & Under (excluding lead rein & 1st ridden)
7. Rider 5 – 10 years
8. Rider 10 years up to & including 17 years
9. Joyce Cocking Memorial Event 12 years & under
10. Joyce Cocking Memorial Event Over 12 Years

Note: Open to financial members of any pony club within the **Midlands Zone only**. All riders must be in Pony Club uniform and the event will be judged on the presentation, riding and suitability of combination for pony club activities

11. **Champion Junior Rider being winner of classes 7 & 8**
12. Novice Pony 14hh & Under (See meaning for Novice at end of hacking program)
13. Pony Hack up to & including 12.2hh
14. Pony Hack over 12.2hh & up to & including 14hh
15. Light Weight Pony Hack up to & including 14hh
16. Medium / Heavy Weight Pony Hack up to & including 14hh
17. Pleasure Pony Hack up to & including 14hh
18. **Champion Pony Hack Winners Classes 12 – 17**
19. Show Pony Hunter up to 12.2HH
20. Show Pony Hunter over 12.2hh up to & including 14hh
21. **Champion Pony Hunter under 14hh: Winners Classes 19 & 20**
22. **Miniature Breed Horse / Pony**
23. **Fancy Dress**

22. Smartest on Parade over 14hh and up to and including 15hh
23. Smartest on Parade over 15hh
24. Rider 18 – 35 years
25. Rider over 35 years
26. **Champion Senior Rider Winners Classes 24 & 25**
27. Novice Hack over 14hh & Over (See meaning for Novice at end of hacking program)
28. Open Hack 14hh & Over
29. Light Weight Hack 14hh & Over
30. Med /Heavy Weight Hack 14hh & Over
31. Pleasure Hack 14hh & Over
32. **Champion Hack over 14hh Winners Classes 27 - 31**
33. Show Hunter 14hh up to and including 15.1hh
34. Show Hunter Over 15.2hh
35. **Champion Show Hunter over 14hh Winners Classes 33 & 34**

NOTE: Meaning of a Novice horse / pony - A horse or pony which has **never won a Novice or Open Championship at any Agricultural Show**. Class is lost once a horse competes in an Open class and is placed either First, Second or Third, or wins Champion.

SHOW JUMPING

COMMENCING 10.00AM SHARP

JUDGE:

Where jumping clashes with other events: Riders must choose which event they ride.

Maximum of **3** Show jumping rounds per horse.

- 3 90cm – Power & Speed
- 4 90cm – AM7
- 5 100cm – Power & Speed
- 6 100cm - AM7

AFTERNOON PROGRAM – NOT TO COMMENCE BEFORE 1PM

- 9 Poles – Optimum Time
- 10 30cm – Optimum Time
- 11 45cm – Power & Speed
- 12 45cm –AM7
- 13 60cm – Power & Speed
- 14 60cm – AM7
- 15 80cm – AM7 (Only open to riders who did not compete in Class 1 or 2)
